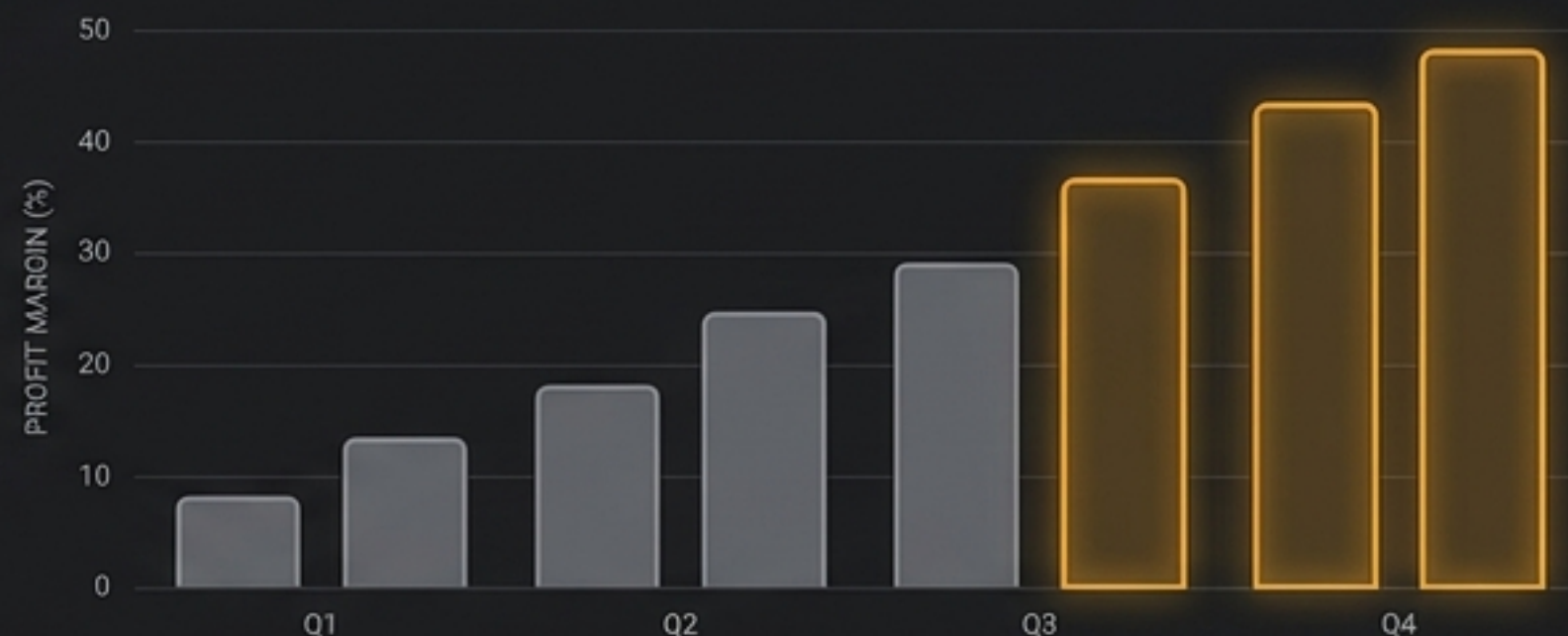

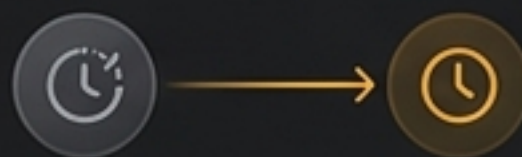

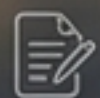

Buyer's Diagnostic: Non-Negotiable Software Requirements

Must be trained on legal language models, not just general LLMs.

Pre-Implementation: The Baseline Assessment

Panel 1: Bottleneck Audit

Document current contract volume. Identify where delays, rework, and risk exposure occur most frequently.

Panel 2: Goal Definition

Establish hard metrics. (e.g., "Reduce NDA review time by 50%").

The 6-Month Phased Deployment Roadmap

Phased Deployment Staircase

Phase 1: Pilot (Months 1-2)

Land-and-expand. Select 5-10 power users. Focus on a single high-volume contract type (e.g., NDAs).

Metric: 30% time reduction.

Phase 2: Department Rollout (Months 3-4)

Standardize workflows based on Pilot data. Build a centralized clause library.

Metric: 80% legal team adoption.

Phase 3: Cross-Functional (Months 5-6)

Extend to Sales/Procurement with strict legal permission controls.

Metric: 40% decrease in overall deal cycle time.

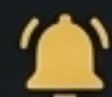

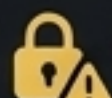
User Resistance

- Do not automate all contract types simultaneously.




Demand Zero Data Retention (ZDR) SLAs

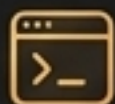

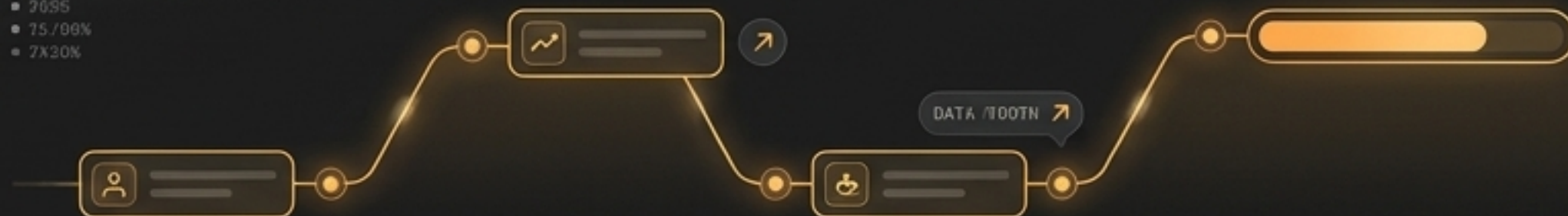
