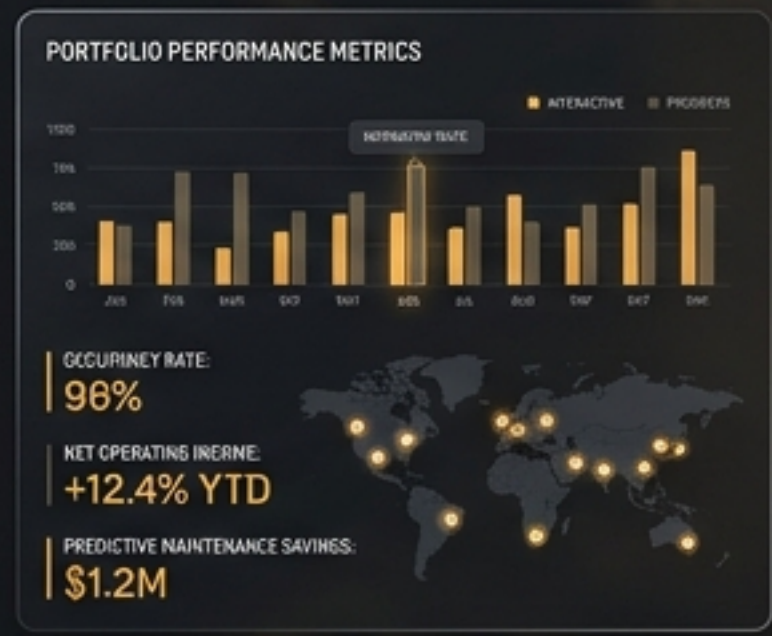

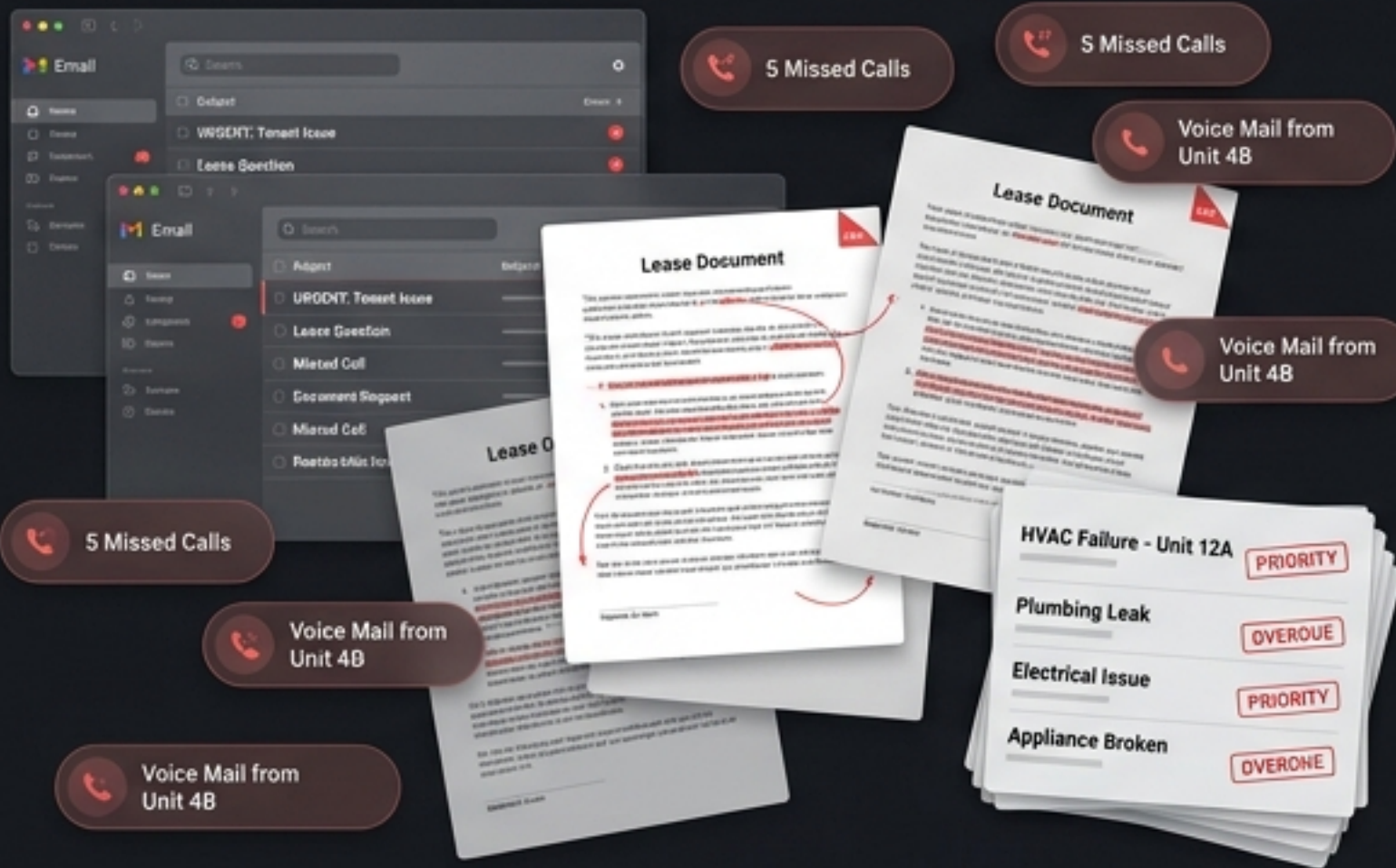

CONSTRUCTING THE AUTONOMOUS LEASING FUNNEL.



GATE 1: INBOUND & SCORING (LeaseHawk LeadScore AI)

AI analyzes inbound calls and voicemails, classifying caller intent to prioritize high-value prospects.

GATE 2: NURTURE & QUALIFICATION (EliseAI / AppFolio Lisa)

Virtual agents handle 24/7 Q&A, qualify leads, and nurture prospects across 47 languages.

GATE 3: TOURING & VERIFICATION (Showdigs)

Prospects self-schedule. AI runs ID/facial recognition verification, then dispatches an on-demand licensed agent or unlocks the smart door.

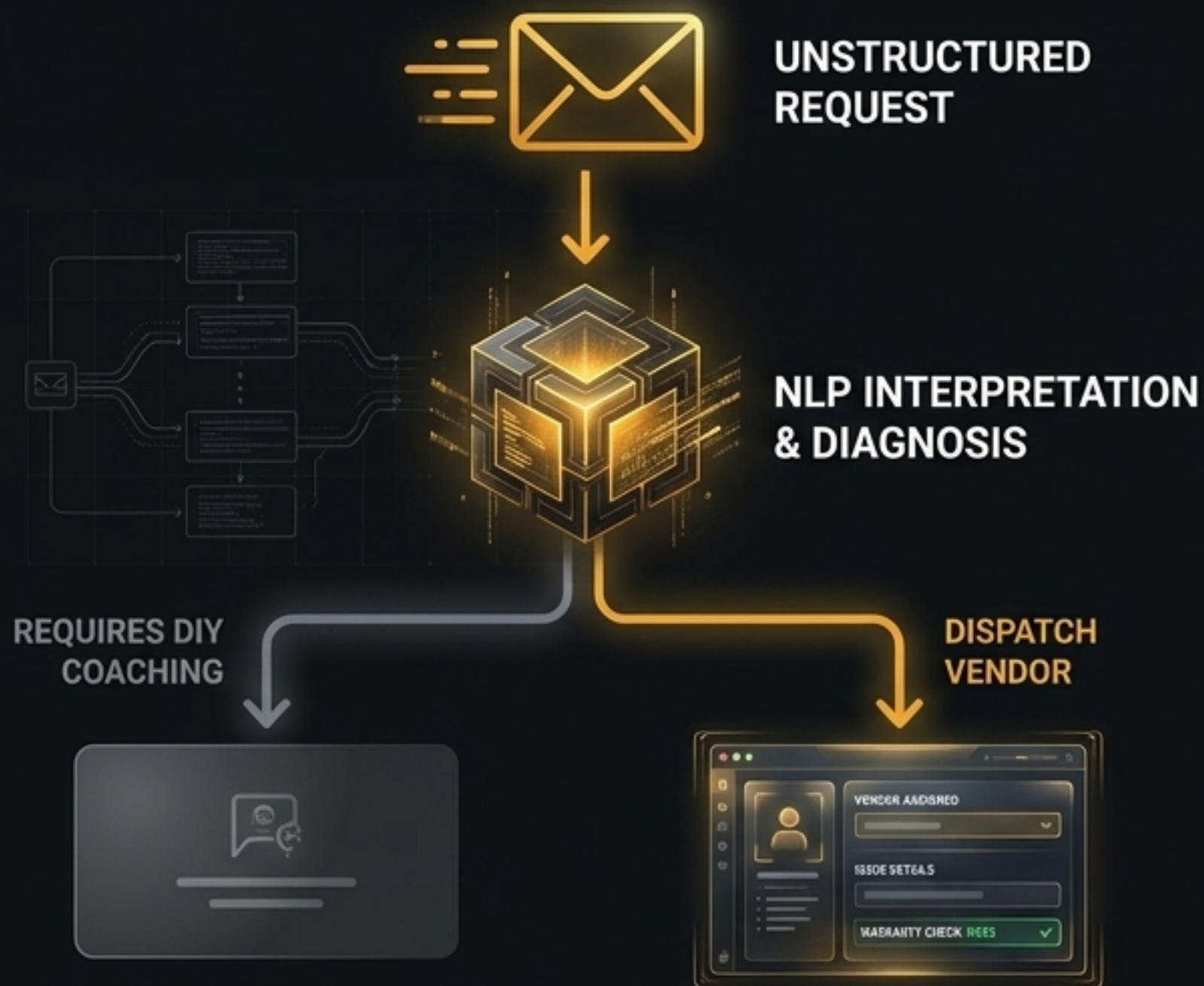

STEP 1: INGESTION

STEP 3: ROUTING (CREDIA ACTION)

AI checks appliance warranties, drafts a detailed work order, and autonomously routes to the correct vendor.

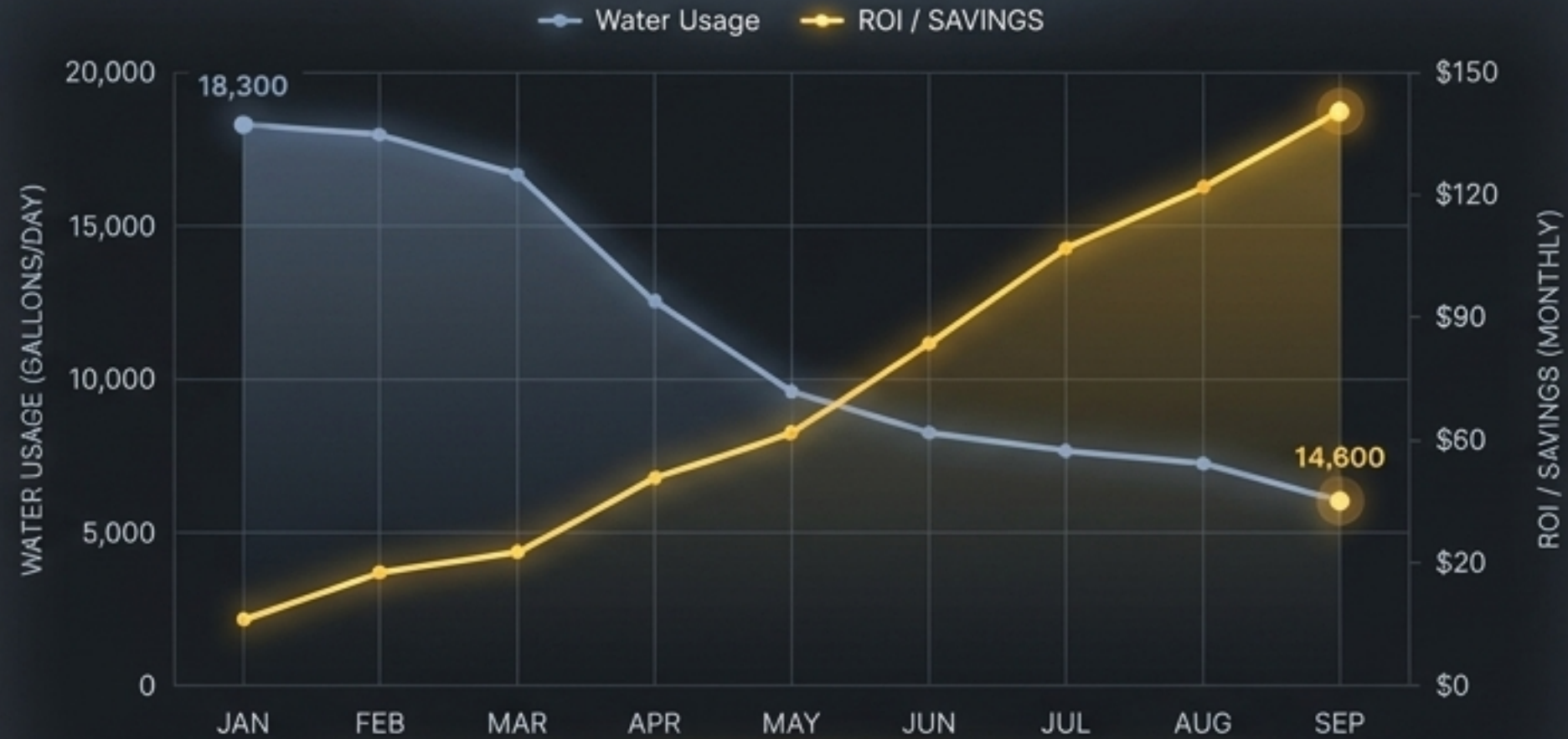

Best for seamless internal workflows. Deeply embedded AI (e.g., AppFolio Realm-X, Re-Leased Credia) can query financial data natively without API latency.

Best for specific edge-cases. Specialized plugins (e.g., EliseAI, SmartRent) require deep, two-way synchronization with existing systems of record (Yardi, MRI) to prevent data silos.

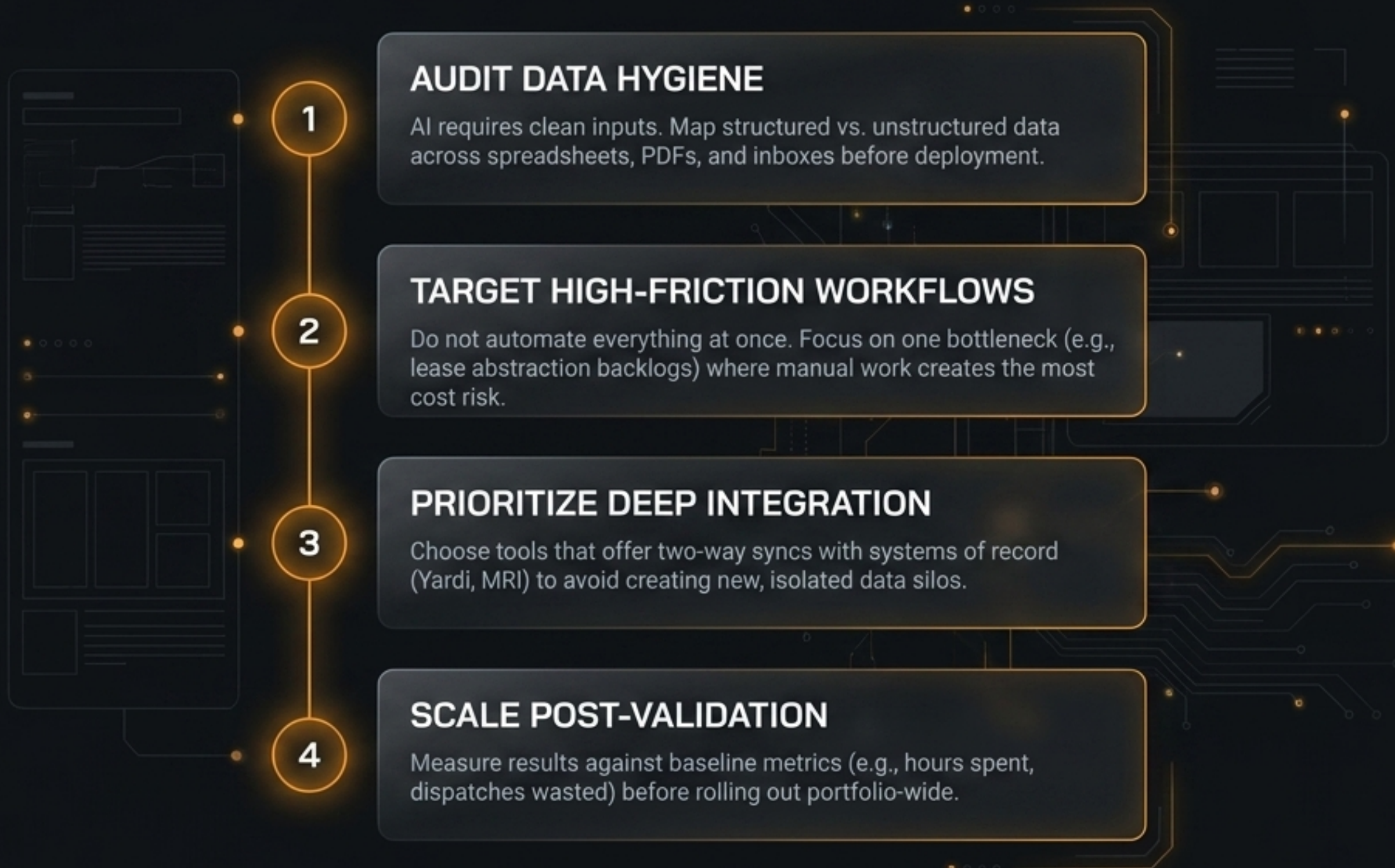

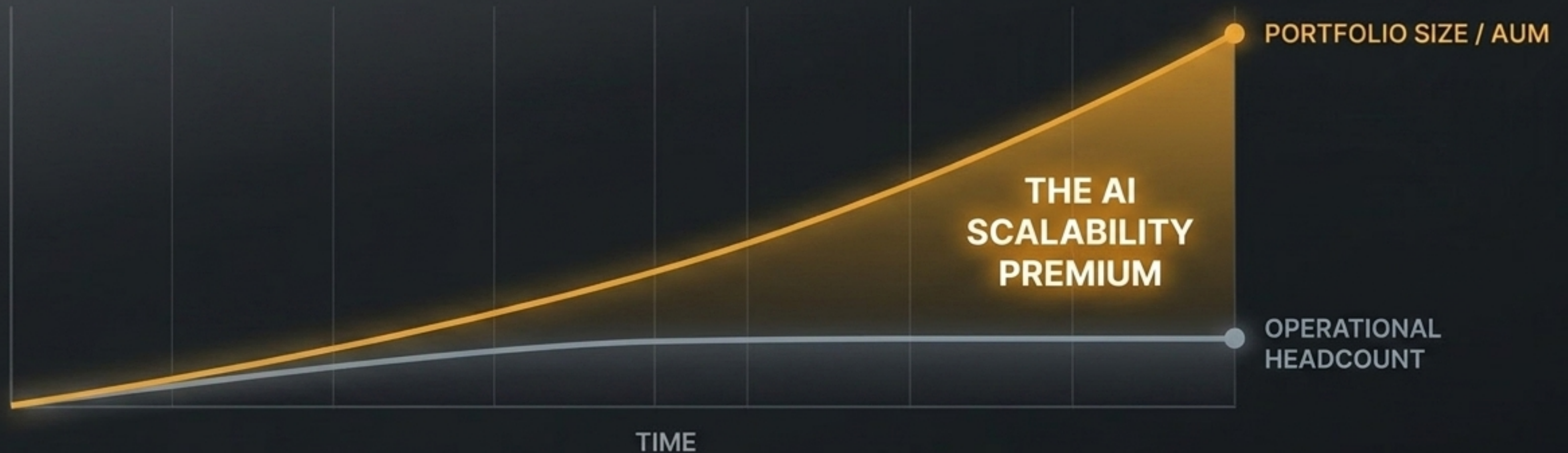
